- GLIA Board is a 100% volunteer neighborhood group using the power of numbers to make a difference





  - Lily Pads are federally protected




View of North Bay on 7/21/2023



## **Weed Control - Overall**


- MAC utilizes chemical treatments
  - Tribune & Copper Sulfate
  - Common lake, pond, and golf course herbicide
- DNR permitted and regulated
- Manual pulling and harvesting have been explored





# **Purple Loosestrife - Bio Control**

- Partnered with Bolton & Menk
- Beetles are strategically placed and feed on Purple Loosestrife
- Approximately 15,000 beetles reared and released in 2024
- Part of a 5-year treatment plan
- Ongoing
